

Information for Colorado Prescribers of Prescription Drugs

Menopur® (menotropins for injection)

- The below pricing information is being provided pursuant to Colorado HB 19-1131 and is accurate as of January 9, 2026. Information about Wholesale Acquisition Cost (WAC) of these drugs is being provided to Colorado prescribers pursuant to Colorado law, to give you information about the relative prices of marketed drugs and other generic drugs in the same therapeutic class.
- The prices listed below are WAC prices, which represent Ferring’s published list prices for the products sold to wholesalers, before any discount, rebate, or other price reduction. The WAC prices listed may differ significantly from actual prices paid by customers and consumers. In addition, a product’s WAC is typically not associated with per-dose pricing, and does not necessarily reflect price per dosage, price per course of treatment or the cost effectiveness of all the products listed.
- Colorado law also requires manufacturers to provide the names of generic prescription drugs from the same “therapeutic class” as the marketed products. Colorado defines “therapeutic class” as “a group of similar drugs that have the same or similar mechanisms of action and are used to treat a specific condition.”
